# **ALLOCATION OF DIRITTO ALLO STUDIO (DSU) ACCOMMODATION**

# 1. Accommodation Assignment Guide – Right to Study (DSU)

Students applying through the Right to Study call can request accommodation in the residence halls of the Politecnico di Milano.

Accommodation is assigned based on official ranking lists, defined according to merit and income requirements. Students who are awarded a place will receive a notification at their institutional email address with the accommodation offer and instructions on how to proceed.

## 2. Accommodation assignment

Places are assigned following the order of the ranking lists, taking into account, where possible, the preferences expressed during the application process.

The accommodation offer is sent via email and must be accepted within 48 hours. If it is not accepted within this timeframe, it will be considered declined and reassigned.

Any places that become available at a later stage (due to withdrawals, failure to check in, or completion of studies) may be assigned to eligible students according to the ranking order.

## 3. Acceptance and obligations

Accepting the accommodation entails:

- Compliance with the Residence Regulations and Service Charter;
- Acceptance of the financial conditions set out in the call;
- Payment of the security deposit;
- Obligation to move into the accommodation within the specified timeframe.

Failure to take possession of the accommodation within the given timeframe will result in forfeiture of the assignment.

Withdrawal after acceptance may result in the application of the relevant charges, including possible deductions from the scholarship.

## 4. Financial conditions

Beneficiary students are entitled to a subsidized rate, the amount of which is set annually by the Lombardy Region.

The rate is the same regardless of the type of room assigned (single or double) and is generally deducted directly from the scholarship.

If the student loses eligibility or is excluded from financial benefits, the full rate may be applied for the entire period of stay.

## 5. Check-in

At check-in, students must:

- Present a valid ID document;
- Sign the accommodation handover report;

- Verify the condition of the room and its furnishings

Check-in must take place within the communicated timeframe (normally within 15 working days from acceptance). Students are responsible for the assigned spaces for the entire duration of their stay.

## 6. Liability and damages

Any damage to rooms, furnishings, or common areas must be promptly reported to the residence management.

Repair costs may be charged to the responsible student. The security deposit may be partially or fully retained to cover damages or contractual breaches.

## 7. Withdrawal and early termination

In case of withdrawal or early termination of the stay, students must notify the relevant office according to the established procedures.

The applicable financial conditions remain in force, including those related to the actual duration of the stay.

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# Glossary

**RECIPIENT/BENEFICIARY:**

a student who, in possession of the merit and income requirements set forth in the call for applications, is assigned Diritto allo Studio preferential-rate housing.

**SCHOLARSHIP:**

financial support, awarded through a call for applications for university students with certain income and merit requirements; this support is recognised partly in cash and partly in student services.

**Annual scholarship:** financial support, including housing deduction for the entire academic year.

**Semester Scholarship:** financial support, includes housing deduction for the first semester of the academic year.

**BENEFIT FORFEITURE:**

a student who falls under the causes of eligibility forfeiture established by the call for applications

**SECURITY DEPOSIT:**

a sum of money paid by the student as a guarantee in case of non-payment of fees, damages or extra cleaning.

**DSU:**

Diritto allo Studio Universitario

**AWAY FROM HOME (FUORI SEDE):**

an "away from home" student takes a housing at the Campus where the lectures of their study programme are held.

**RANKING:**

list establishing the sequential order of Call for applications participants based on income and merit requirements.

**INELIGIBLE RECIPIENT:**

a student who meets all the merit and income requirements under the Call for applications, who is not assigned housing due to lack of availability.

**INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY:**

a student selected by the University to carry out a study project abroad.

**INELIGIBLE:**

a student who does not meet the income and merit requirements in the Call for applications.

**HOUSING PLACE:**

use of a bed in a double or single room for the duration of the benefit for the academic year.

**SCHOLARSHIP REVOCATION:**

a student who incurs forfeiture of benefit eligibility in the current academic year and who must return the amounts received for scholarship or the value of the housing.

**WITHDRAWING STUDENT:**

a student who does not accept the housing place provided, or, due to withdrawal from studies they waive the housing assigned.

**PREFERENTIAL RATE:**

a fixed flat rate, established annually by the Lombardy Regional Government, withheld from the scholarship or paid by the student for the housing place assigned.

**FULL RATE:**

housing cost without reductions applied according to the residence and type of room assigned to the guest.
